The Assumption of the Blessed Mother

Monday, August 15, is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Mother. This is where we recall Mary being assumed, body and soul, into heaven. Usually this is one of those Holy Days of Obligation; however, since it falls on a Monday it is not an obligatory day this year ... don't ask me why this is the case. Regardless, it's a wonderful time to not only remember Mary; but, also to consider what this Solemnity says about our lives right now. Why could Mary's life be assumed into something greater? Simply put, she never allowed those "earthly" things to weigh her down. We say Mary is without sin, which is another way of saving that her focus was perfectly on the Lord and not deflected by the distractions of the world. When we allow the concerns of this world to weigh on us (no matter how important the concern is) to the point where it compromises our focus on the Lord, we prevent ourselves from receiving our Lord's grace. Its His grace which transforms our lives, brings peace to our soul, provides that lasting happiness...essentially, His grace is what assumes our life into something more than what we can achieve on our own. While this solemnity is not obligatory this year, it would be good to take time and simply ask: what am I allowing to weigh on me right now, and how should my focus be more like Mary's. By taking time with this simple examination, and having a willingness to carry through any necessary changes, we will start sensing the effects of our Lord's grace!

On a side note, I received some questions and requests for the Anointing of the Sick. I am more than happy to administer this important sacrament, so never hesitate to ask. Unfortunately with being new, I have no idea of who is in need or who has already received the sacrament. So, if you know of someone who needs to be anointed, kindly reach out to me.
