**School Supplies for Dayton Tornado Victims**

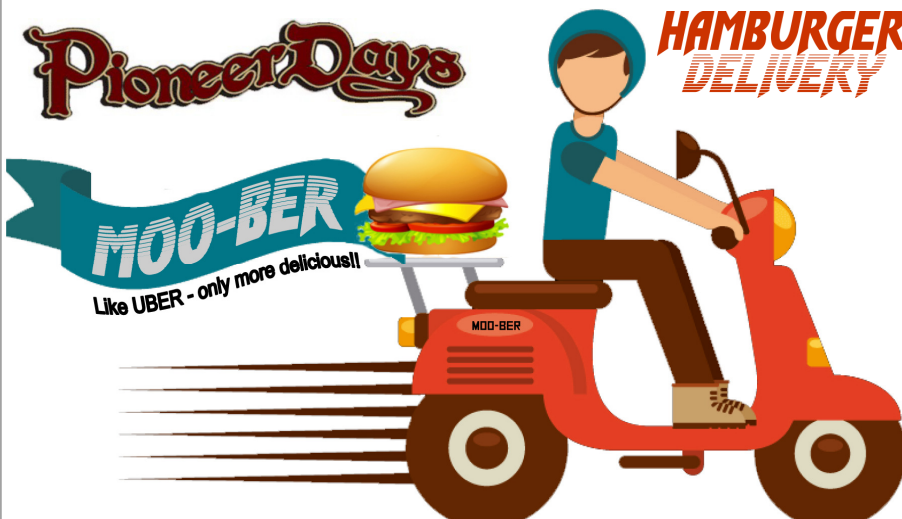
