From the Desk of Fr. Mark

Hi, everyone,

It is Christmas week and I'm not quite ready. Each year I try to do several things which put me in the right spirit to celebrate this once in an eternity occasion. There is nothing like it in history, present or to come. For God to share His love with us in this particular way is amazing. For the God of all power and might to share His love with all humanity through the humanity of a child is brilliant. To share love is all the gift He is asking of all of us to give. At Christmas, it seems easier to love God, family, neighbor and even our enemies. The statement that the gift of Christ is the gift of love is so true.

To get ready for Christmas I try to take extra time to love. The first stop in my preparation for Christmas always takes me to a local barn. In the past, I have felt so at peace that I have fallen asleep as I think of Jesus, Mary and Joseph surrounded by the simplicity of creation. It may be below freezing on the outside, but there is a warmth in reflecting on the birth of our Lord. I like the smell of hay and the sound of sparrows and pigeons. We are so much more than a sparrow or grass in the field. Jesus was born for all of us and for everyone, even me. I think of cattle "lowing" or being still. Can I be still and leave the cares of the world to be swallowed up by the gentleness of a child and the closeness of God? As the breeze flows through the cracks in the barn siding, do I allow the Holy Spirit to move me to say yes to God's plans like Mary did so many years ago? I think of a barn and not a castle. Jesus makes even the smallest great and part of a whole different kind of kingdom.

My second stop in preparation is a pile of Christmas cards and a list of people from my past. I usually send my cards out after Christmas. I take time before Christmas to make sure I pray and have thoughts of love for people on my list. So many people have been such a blessing to me over the years. I feel connected to people from assignments in Orlando to Virginia. From Ohio to New Zealand, God has blessed me with faith and love-filled people. I have spent more time with my church families than my blood family. So, I have lots of family members. By the time I go through all my lists, I am ready to celebrate the love of Christmas.

Lastly, I recall our farm tradition around Christmas was to take special care of the animals on Christmas eve. On the night when we were so excited to get back to the house for opening of presents, we took extra time to make the animals on the farm extra comfortable. The softest straw was used for bedding. The greenest hay was fed that night. I even took time to talk to the cows as they were milked. So many people have made my life more comfortable. The staff, committee members and people in the pews have done so much work to make our churches come alive with the love of God. When I see our churches growing and happy, I feel the joy of the Lord. When I personally have had difficult times, like my siblings' illness and death, it is nice to have so many people bring comfort. And it is nice to have people let me be crazy me. Thanks and Merry Christmas. A special shout out to Fr. Elmer. He has to put up with a lot. He brings lots of joy to the house.

By Wednesday, I will be ready. I hope you will be ready, also. My wish for everyone is to know the love of the Lord deep in your hearts. And as we would like to hold the baby, Jesus, let Him hold us because He first loved us.
