From the Desk of Fr. Mark

Hi, everyone. Lent is upon us and I'm smiling rather than paying attention to the ashes on my forehead. It is Wednesday as I write this and I just came back from a whole church full of people. Our school children led the Mass, with singing and reading of the scriptures. I am smiling because the church was not only full of people, but also full of prayer. If singing is praying twice, the church was doubly full. Today was a day I wish all of you could be a priest. To be in an atmosphere where it is easy to be overtaken by a sea of people who believe and overwhelmed by voices praising God is a great thing and really helps me on my faith journey. One song that was sung this morning was "Indescribable." You can't put into words the sight and sound of God's creation and so many people praising God. Throughout this Lenten season, our parishes will offer prayer opportunities. There are Stations of the Cross, daily Mass, special prayer opportunities, booklets, etc. One special opportunity that I would like to highlight is the the website "Formed.org." The last prayer opportunity that I would like to highlight as we begin Lent is the prayer board at the entrances of our churches. As people enter or exit, a person or family can put on the board their request for the week. Our whole community can pray for that intention throughout the week and at Mass. The board will be wiped clean so that every weekend new prayer requests or prayers of thanksgiving can be added. Let us pray as a church family.
