

From the Desk of Fr. Mark

Hi, everyone.

A lot can happen in a week. This past weekend assignments in the Cincinnati diocese were announced. My name just happened to be on the assignment list. Starting July 1, I will be assigned to a family of parishes in Mercer and Auglaize Counties. It is a good thing that I am used to a big family because the grouping of parishes where I will be ministering includes eight different churches. These parishes include: Holy Redeemer in New Bremen, St. Rose in St. Rose, St. Sebastian in St. Sebastian, Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Cassella, Precious Blood in Chickasaw, St. John the Baptist in Maria Stein, St. Augustine in Minster and St. Joseph in Egypt. I am not sure how all this will work out as joining eight churches together has never been done before. I asked my superior that I not be a pastor so that I can have time to visit with my family. These parishes are close to my home town and a number of family members live in these eight parishes. It will be good to be close to family and good to have three other priests to work together to handle the Mass schedules. This should allow me time to visit family and friends with a little time to farm and spend time in the woods. I'm not sure where I will be living and will fill you in when I know more. These parishes are a little more than an hour away, so I hope to come back to see all of you and come back for Baptisms, Weddings and just any occasion so that I can spend time with my Putnam County family. Of course, I expect all of you to come visit. People have asked if I know who is coming to St. Michael's and St. John's. I don't know. It is the life of a missionary. A missionary is open to the promptings of the Holy Spirit and will serve where we are called. God has not let me down yet. God is good all the time and everywhere. God sure has been good to me over these past 13 years.

There is still a lot of work to be done and a lot of play to happen before I take off at the end of June. I am not very good at goodbyes, so please pray for me. I will be praying for all of you and the new pastor who will be coming here. He is a lucky man. I will keep you informed as soon as I know anything about who will be coming here. It will be a Precious Blood priest so there should be a sense of missionary in him. Don't expect him to be like me (I told you he was a lucky man). Each person has their own gifts from God. I'm sure he will show God to you in many new ways. It is always a challenge to change pastors, but oftentimes challenges present new opportunities to grow in the Lord. Keep growing. God is amazing and no one person can capture the fullness of God. That is why changing pastors, although difficult is oftentimes really good.

I knew this day would come, but to see it in print makes it more real. Again, let's pray for each other during this transition time. And I want to have enough fun with all of you. I have always believed that God wants us to live life to the fullest that we can. And I believe that includes lots of joy.



Students Planning Mass This Week...


