#### From the Desk of Fr. Nathan

Dear St. John's and Michael's parishes,

Greetings to all of you. Its with much excitement and joy that I can finally introduce myself, I'm your new priest, Fr. Nathan Bockrath. I can't wait to get started and to meet all of you. I feel blessed that the bishop assigned me as your priest, and I'm humbled by the responsibility.

First off, thank you for your patience here in the month of July. Typically the transition between priests is immediate; however, the bishop has me in "summer-school" in Washington D.C., in the pursuit of a Canon Law degree for the diocese. If you don't know what that is, consider yourself lucky. In short, canon law is a refection of all the norms that govern how the Catholic Church operates and functions. Everything from who has the right to be baptized, to how to start a new diocese, to what to do if you don't like your pastor (hopefully, an experience that I won't make a reality for you). So, every diocese needs several canon lawyers to make sure things run smoothly. The program is four summers long, and I'm in summer three. Our Lord willing, I will be done next summer.

A little bit about myself, I was born and raised in Glandorf. Putnam County has always had a special place in my heart, which was particularly reinforced when I moved away for college. When you live here, its easy to take things for granted; however, there are few places like Putnam Co. I went to college at the University of Dayton, during which time I was also studying with the Missionaries of the Precious Blood (the same religious community that Frs. Scott Kramer and Mark Hoying belong to). It was some good years with them, but I felt our Lord was calling me to the diocesan priesthood. So, upon graduation, I transferred to the Toledo diocese. At which time, I continued seminary at Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Cincinnati (where Kalida's own Fr. Jason Kahle studied). I really enjoyed my time there. It was very enriching and helped confirm my priestly vocation.

In 2013 I was ordained a priest and my first assignment was as an associate priest at Norwalk St. Paul's, and chaplain to their preK-12 school. In 2015, I was then assigned as the associate priest for St. Joseph and St. Ann's parishes in Fremont, chaplain and teacher at their k-12 school, and administrator of Mother of Sorrows parish on Put-in-Bay and St. Michaels parish on Kelleys Island (yep, they got churches on those islands, too). For the sake of brevity, these were all wonderful years. It was great working with the young people, meeting all sorts of folks, and truly a great places to be a priest for my first several years. In 2018, I was assigned the pastor for Our Lady of Hope parish in Attica and St. Gaspar parish in Bellevue. I was bit nervous considering all the responsibilities; but, it turned out to be great. Wonderful people there, we got some projects completed, navigated the craziness of covid, and it was simply edifying to journey in the faith with them.

So, that brings me to today. As I mentioned, I am really looking forward to meeting all of you, learning about the area (I've been away for 17 years), and overall to be your priest. I'll be starting to settle into the office this week and I hope to see you next weekend, as that will be my first weekend Mass. If you need to contact me, don't hesitate to reach out.
