

From the Desk of Fr. Mark

Hi, everyone.

It's packing time. Today, a group of pilgrims heading to Africa are packing up supplies for the orphanages and hospitals around Tanzania. As we packed, we realized how little we know about the people we will be visiting. Do we pack sidewalk chalk? Do they have sidewalks? Do we pack contact solution as part of the medical supplies we are bringing? Does anyone have contacts? I figure that it isn't what comes out of the suitcases which will make a difference in the long run. What comes out of and what goes back into our hearts which will touch a lifetime. So many people have donated medical supplies, basic health needs, games and toys, stuffed animals and school supplies, soccer uniforms and socks. We have a wide assortment of goodies to share with people, as we travel around Tanzania. So many supplies were collected, that a container in St. Henry, Ohio, will transfer the remaining supplies to Tanzania. Thanks to all who will be bringing smiles across the world.

As we packed, I thought of everyone who will be packing this summer. There are short trips and long trips which always require some packing. On our trip, we are only carrying the essentials. Our big luggage will be housing supplies for the orphanages, schools and hospitals. Our carry-ons and back packs will be what we live out of. What is essential to bring along? What can I live with or live without? Each time we pack, that thought comes to mind. Going across the world makes the question more relevant as we just can't go around the corner to pick up what we forgot. We can't just make a u-turn and be back home.

What is essential? What can I not live without? Did I pack my faith or does that always come with me? Does God take up much space in my carry-on? Will I be sharing faith so that there is room to bring new faith back with me? Most people will do some packing this summer. Is God essential?

Three weeks and counting. Thanks for all the donated items and your prayers. May God be part of our summer and each day.
