## From the Desk of Fr. Mark

I'm writing this from North Carolina, where I've been on retreat this week with the Florida mission group, who came last year and helped during the flood.

A woman here showed us southern hospitality by serving Southern-style BBQ pork, complete with coleslaw on top. As she served the sandwiches, she was speaking a language I wasn't sure I knew; it was difficult to understand. After listening to her for a while, I realized she just had a strong accent. As I look at a river which runs right by our cabin, and see the tall trees and different kinds of birds, I realize that God's language is sometimes like an accent. As I listen to people from Florida, they have an accent, and they thought I had one, too.

After living in Putnam County for seven years, I have an accent of farming and flat lands; it may not be strong, but it's still an accent. To see God's eyes through our own particular traditions and hearing His voice with our own accent is good; but by exposing ourselves to other accents, we get to hear God's voice in different ways. The last couple of days with the Florida group helped me do just that. A teenager definitely hears God's voice differently than I do. I never realized God stayed up so late or was so tired early in the morning. But I realized that God does have an accent, if we're just open to hearing other voices.

The Florida kids would love to come back and visit and even talked about doing another mission trip in Kalida. I said they could come, but to not bring a flood like last time.

Listen for God in other accents. Be open to God in new ways; you never know what you can learn. Have a great week, everyone.
