## From the Desk of Fr. Mark

Hi, everyone. I feel good. It is amazing what a couple of good nights' sleep will do for you. For the past three months, I had lost my sleep pattern. This knee surgery had more implications than I had anticipated. For some reason I am back in a good groove and feel more like myself. I was wondering if I had become a different person.

There was a different time in my life that I felt the same thing: right before my ordination 33 years ago. At that time, I had so much going through my mind that I could not sleep. I walked the farm fields at three in the morning and talked to God. Was being a priest the person God wanted me to be? I prayed for myself and the future parishes which may get me (I praved for you guys even before I met you). Couldn't being married with a family fulfill me just as it did Mom and Dad? Wouldn't being a farmer and a good steward of the soil make God and me happy? 33 years ago I did some pretty serious praying. What I came up with was that this call to serve as a priest was just in me. No matter how many questions I asked or how much time I spent trying to put it away, the call to be a priest was just in me. And that is how I described it to people when they asked why I was becoming a priest. It was just in me. I could be happy with other calls, but the call to serve as a priest would make me happiest of all because it was the most authentic and from the depths of who I am. I recall very vividly that last three o'clock in the morning as I strolled the entire farm and went through every building on the farm to know that when I responded to the call to priesthood at ten in the morning, that morning, I was ready to say I was ready.



Next weekend, Deacon Matt Keller, who was assigned here, will be ordained a priest at Maria Stein at 10 o'clock. I wonder if he will pray as hard and lose sleep like I did. Matt's journey has taken ten years of learning, questioning and praying. Let's pray for him that God's call will be celebrated this coming Saturday morning. May he find peace and joy in God's call to priesthood and serving God's people. I hope he sleeps this week in knowing that the call is in him.

This weekend, we celebrate the feast of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. For me, this is a special occasion because I am a member of the Missionaries of the Precious Blood. In the old Church calendar, there were two feasts, the Body of Christ (Corpus Christi) and the Precious Blood, which was celebrated on July 1. The two feasts were put together on one Sunday. So, for this one Sunday, I celebrate with my fellow Precious Blood missionaries that Jesus would give all that He was for our lives. Blood throughout the scriptures meant life. For Him to shed every drop of His precious blood for life for all of us still inspires me as I try to live fully in service to others. Every time I take in the Body and Blood of Christ I say, "Amen" to a full life here and in the life to come. I think of past and current missionaries who are people of life, life in the Lord. I think of the future Fr. Matt and pray that Jesus' life is in him and that Matt will give this life to others as a Missionary of the Precious Blood.
