

From the Desk of Fr. Mark



Hi, everyone.

These past weekends have been First Communion weekends, and I always enjoy them. There are certain occasions in the Church that make the Church so alive. First Communion weekends are just such occasions. First, the children are so full of energy. I've asked them if they love Jesus and they easily, joyfully and enthusiastically say that they do. Their voices scream their devotion to Jesus. If we all could have that enthusiasm for the Lord, I believe the world would be different/better. When the Church asks us to evangelize, I see children such as these. God's Spirit in them is attractive and contagious. Parents, Godparents, grandparents, the pastor and the whole Church smiles with the young people who are saying yes to receiving the Lord.

Second, I see parents (who said yes at Baptism for these voung people) who are filled with heartfelt love as their children are continuing their faith journeys. It is one thing to see the children grow physically or grow talent-wise through academics or athletics, but to see them grow in faith touches hearts like nothing else. 
