School is Out?

This weekend, we recognized and congratulated all our seniors at Mass. Many years of hard work has led to this moment of their graduation, and through these years, we have had the chance to see their God-given talents develop. Our parish is very proud of each of them! In addition, to all of our students who have completed their current grade: congratulations to all of you, as well. Certainly with this school year coming to end, there is a natural sense to think that school is over. True enough; however, in a deeper sense, school, the process of learning/growing with our Lord, never stops. Jesus said right before his Ascension, "I have much more to tell you" (JN 16:12). Through the Holy Spirit, our Lord always wants to speak to our hearts in order to direct, to guide, to school us. So, if we ever adopt the attitude that "this is good enough" or "you can't teach old dogs new tricks," it may feel convenient; but, we are frustrating our ability to hear this life-giving teaching of our Lord's. Rather, we need a spirit of being incomplete, of openness, of hunger for real learning. As Samuel said: "Speak Lord, for you servant is listening" (1 Sm 3:9). May Samuel's prayer be our prayer as we enter these months.

While our students are physically out of school, that is not true for your priest. As many of you know, the Bishop has me going to "summer school" in Washington D.C. This is for a Canon Law degree (that is Church Law), and this is my last summer of the four-summer program. I will leave on Memorial Day and won't return until mid-August. Don't worry, we have retired priests lined up to cover the Masses. If a funeral arises, the office staff will help coordinate a priest for the Mass. In addition, if you or a fellow parishioner needs the Last Rites, the office staff or hospital can help with contacting a priest. Finally, for reconciliation, there will still be the opportunity on Thursday evenings at 6:45 p.m., but not on Saturday. Always feel to grab a priest before or after Mass to make a confession. While this set-up isn't ideal, this is the last summer for this, and it too will pass. God Bless,
