From the Desk of Fr. Mark

Hi, everyone. I'm writing this on St. Gaspar Day, October 21. St. Gaspar founded the Missionaries of the Precious Blood in Italy at the time of Napoleon. He loved the Lord so much that he defied Napoleon and ended up in prison for not giving allegiance to the French leader. His love for the Lord inspired him to found a group of missionaries that would renew the Church in Italy after many years of wars. The times were tough and not very Christian (Kind of sounds familiar). His determined love for the Lord helped him to remain steadfast through prison and many hardships. His work was blessed by the Lord and the Missionaries of the Precious Blood are now found in countries around the world. That same missionary spirit leads the priests, brothers and sisters of today to preach, live and renew the world we live in today.

This Sunday is Mission Sunday around the world. The Church prays for those called to share the Gospel message with others. When I was much younger, I thought of mission places around the world such as Africa or, like Fr. Elmer, China. To have others know about the Lord and live a Christian life was in my heart. That missionary spirit is still in my heart, but I don't have to go far from home. I believe that we are all called to have a missionary spirit wherever God calls us. We just have to be willing to allow God to use us to spread the Gospel.

This week we are blessed to have a missionary speaker join to help inspire that missionary spirit in all of us. Richard Lane comes to us from Michigan (What good can come from Michigan? They said the same thing about Jesus when he spread the Gospel.) He has an interesting story and promises to have a message that will put our souls on fire. Make plans to join us for this exciting speaker. If you can't join in person, we will be broadcasting his presentations on channel 70. Mark your calendars to join us for each night or every night. People have asked if it is the same presentation each night. It is different every night.

One last thought about being a missionary. It was thought that a missionary would "give" God to people who did not know God or His life through the Gospel of Jesus. Today it is presumed that God is already there because God is everywhere. We used to talk about pagans and looked down rather than look around. Jesus lived, died and rose for all people. Missionaries of today respect the journey which people take and try to walk the journey with them, rather than tell them where and how to walk God's call.

Have a great week, everyone. I will see you at the mission and we will celebrate being on fire for the Lord.
