Hi, everyone. I'm getting ready for Friday night. Years ago, that might have meant getting ready for a football game or a night out with friends. This Friday night I am getting ready to pray for the Church. The bishop has asked the Church of Toledo diocese to have time set aside on the feast of The Exaltation of the Cross to pray and fast for our Church in the face of the abuse scandal of our Church. Even though you will be reading this after the fact, I think it is still relevant to continue to pray and fast for our Church, and not only on September 14.

As I thought about what I wanted to pray about, I thought about the wonder of our faith. My faith is in a God who is amazingly good to us. Each person has their own story of God's presence in their lives. Sometimes God's presence and wonder is with a person. Sometimes God's presence is with a family or community. In everything, God is always good. No matter if a person or family or community has its failings, God is always good. And I believe that through all the failings of our Church or its leaders that we read about or heard about, we will be alright. I don't believe this because we have great leaders or a great institution, but we have a God who will never abandon us. When we turn to the Lord and are directed by Him we will be more than victorious. When people ask me about my thoughts on the abuse scandal, I always have hope. Jesus showed us that sin and death have been conquered. And the sins of our time are small to the love which is forever. No greater love is there than the love He showed us by laying down His life for us. And then He rose and so will we rise from this scandal because our faith is in the name of the Lord.

My prayers are for those who have been abused. May the Lord, who wants us all healed, be with the abused. May our love for them help in the healing process. For all those who have been hurt due to abuse. For those who have had their faith shattered. May the Lord, who can heal the brokenhearted, mend lives. For those who have abused and those who still abuse, be so touched by the Lord to bring a change of heart. May hearts of stone be made soft and ready to love as the Lord loves.

There is much to pray about at this time in the history of the Church. Only by turning to the God who is always with us will life turn around for the good. Let us pray...not only on one day, but all our days so that we stay close to the One who is close to us. Have a good week. *Fr. Mark*
