Our Council and Club are getting back somewhat towards normal as we reach the fall of the year. Our finances are a bit tight with the loss of ½ the Fish Fry's and several weddings and banquets, but we are again hosting receptions with the support and input from the County Health Dept, who have been very helpful. We decided to reduce summer meetings to only 1 per month and will probably do that again next summer. At this point we'll be able to stay on course unless we get some unexpected expenses. One thing we are MISSING is about 190 members who are past due on 2020 member dues. We are working through a call list, but if you do NOT have your 2020 member card you are late. We are short over \$4000 in dues this year, probably because of loss of our usual social functions and fish frys, where many members tended to stay up to date.


We did do an excellent job with our Charity Campaign tickets this year, selling 1258 – most in ten years, thus collecting \$6290 for Charity, of which \$4000 stays with our council for local work. Thanks to everyone who participated in this campaign. A great job and we could have done even more without the virus. In terms of officers, we essentially had a “do-over”. With no meetings for several months we elected to hold no elections this year. We are still short a Deputy Grand Knight. Is it you?

This issue is only available electronically this fall since our funds are low and we wish to retain as much as possible for charitable projects and our other responsibilities. We will be back in print in 2020. Consider coming out to one of our meetings – we need active participation for a truly active council. As we emerge from the pandemic in the coming months, think about what can be done in your parish and community together within the Knights.

FR. MUEHE COUNCIL NEWS

Our Council was recently awarded “Holy Orders” for our support of Seminarians in the Toledo Diocese – see plaque. The SOS program – **Support Our Seminarians** – has been around



for a long time. Typically we simply passed a jar around at regular meetings and attendees would drop a buck or two in the jar. Starting with the 2020 Member breakfast, we had the jar out at the dues table, and later at the Fish Fry table. With the extra money thus gained we were able to fund the SOS program with over \$1300 dollars. In addition, each council has been asked to adopt a seminarian. We chose Travis Kahle, son on the late Tim Kahle of Kalida and his wife Lois. Travis's grandmother was Imogene Kahle. Last year we were able to donate \$500 to Travis to further his studies toward the priesthood. Keep him in your prayers and feed the SOS jar at every event!

We have resumed regular meetings but ask that everyone continue to follow plague guidelines we are all so familiar with. A decision was made to only have one meeting in summer months, when less business is required. At the end of every fraternal year we submit a few reports to the State and Supreme Councils. One of these is “Report of Officers Chosen” – where we left the list as is for the 2020-2021 year. Another is the Semi-Annual Audit report, where we review changes in membership and the flow of money in and out. Membership declined overall slightly, but the big change was in income. With the loss of ½ the Fish Fry's and several banquets and weddings, we are well off a usual year and right now we'll just make it to the first fish fry. Hopefully we can weather the storms of 2020 as Columbus did with three small ships. Can you name them?

THE CHALLENGE OF REFORM AND PRESERVING UNITY WITHIN THE CHURCH CALLS FOR NATURAL AND SUPERNATURAL VIRTUE

EARLIER THIS YEAR, I attended the consecration of a beautifully restored church. As the Blessed Sacrament was placed in the new tabernacle, I thought of the Ark of the Covenant, which was the place of God's presence among his people, beginning in the time of Moses. Now, in the New Covenant, the Lord's true presence is a reality wherever Mass is celebrated and wherever the Eucharist is reserved.

As Catholics, we may take this reality for granted today, but the initial reaction to Jesus' discourse on the bread of life was one of disbelief — the Jews saying, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" and his disciples saying, "This is a hard saying, who can listen to it?" Most of his disciples actually left, and Jesus then turned to the Apostles: "Will you also go away?" As we know, Peter answered, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life" (Jn 6:68).

Jesus' question remains painfully real in light of the devastating scandals that have recently rocked the Church and the declining church attendance among Catholics. And if Jesus' question has new relevance, so does Peter's answer. If we were to turn away from the presence of the Lord, where would we go?
