I think I preferred getting shot. I now think of the shoe clerks and pity them for what our family put them through. After a whole summer of bare feet walking through stables of pigs and cows, the Hoying children's feet were stained and had a distinctive farm aroma. The shoe store clerk would spend a whole day (it sure seemed like a whole day) fitting the Hoying family with shoes. And then the clerk would ask a really foolish question, "Would you like to wear your shoes home?" Those shoes would only come out of the box on the first day of school and then only when the school bus was at the next door neighbor's house.

So here is to all the parents who have to get their children ready for school. May God bless you. We always think of the children getting ready for school, but don't give parents enough credit. So, parents, God bless you and remember that it could be worse. You could have had a boy like me. No wonder no one has named their child Mark.
