Interested in Joining the Catholic Church?

This summer, we will be offering an accelerated OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults) for persons wanting to join the Catholic Church. This program is designed for persons who already have some familiarity with Catholic customs and practices. For example, someone who completed several years of CCD as a child or has been married to a Catholic and attended Mass regularly for a few years would be an ideal candidate for this accelerated program. The classes will take place during the summer months and the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, First Communion) will be celebrated at a Mass in late summer or early fall. **Please reach out to Fr. Our regular OCIA program will begin in the fall and will meet regularly through the spring. This program is an excellent way to learn more about Catholic teachings and customs, build Christian friendships, and eventually choose to become Catholic or not.
