1. What struck you from the video?

4. Jesus’s first words in the Gospel are “What do you seek?” What are you looking for in your life right now?

Episode 2 **Who Are You?**

1. It’s easy to confuse small with insignificant. Why is that true?
2. What is your reaction to the marvels of the human body?
3. Following C.S. Lewis’s line of thought, do you think there is a God-shaped hole inside each of us that only God can fill? Why or why not?
4. Chris mentioned how Jesus began his ministry with the question “What are you looking for?” What do you think about the possibility that God is looking for you?

Episode 3 **Why a God?**

1. Are all humans by nature religious?
2. Why is it reasonable to hold that God exists?
3. Has science disproved God’s existence?
4. What is the relationship of science to faith? How are they similar, and how are they different?

Episode 4 **What’s Our Story?**

1. Why are humans interested in stories?
2. What’s your story? Where were you born, and how did you come to live where you live now?
3. How did you react when they shared the foundations of the Christian story?

4. What is your personal favorite part of the story of God that we find in Scripture? Why?

Episode 5 **Who is Jesus?**

1. Many people think of Jesus as a prophet, a really nice man, or perhaps even the Son of God. Who do you say Jesus was?
2. What is your reaction to C.S. Lewis's statement that Jesus was either "Lord, liar, or lunatic"?
3. Christ said we can know that God exists by thinking about it. But knowing who God is—that's another story. If Jesus reveals who God is, what does he reveal?
4. What from the presentation have you not considered before about Jesus?

Episode 6 **Am I Saved?**

1. What was your reaction to the story about the father and son in the Armenian earthquake?
2. How would you have reacted to Jesus when he said, "Put out your nets for a catch" after you hadn't caught anything all night?
3. Chris mentioned that we often define ourselves by what has happened to us or by what we struggle with. What are those things? Is this true? Is there more?
4. Is salvation a one-time thing?

Episode 7 **Why A church?**

1. Do you know any "nones"?
2. What has been your experience of the Church? Good, bad, and ugly....
3. What has your journey of The Search meant to you?
4. Chris explained that the word "missa" said at the end of Mass meant "sent". As you are sent, what will you do after The Search?
5. Does it make sense that the Catholic church emphasizes ritual, symbol, and rhythm as being important in the life of faith? Why?
