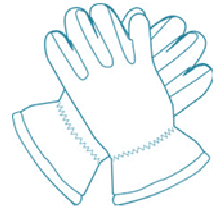

What to Pack:

- Old Clothes for cleaning and painting: T-shirts (no spaghetti strap shirts – remember modesty); shorts or jeans (**no short shorts**, must be fingertip length); tennis shoes must be worn at sites (you can bring flip-flops and gym shoes for evening events).
- Sweatshirts & pants for any outside evening activities, clean clothes for each evening
- Pillow, sleeping bag, towels & wash cloths, toiletries, all shower supplies, suntan lotion (might also want air mattress, cot or cushion)
